

Regional Reorganization Impact on District Directors

Each sitting District Director is entitled to complete his present term and is also entitled to an additional three year term. In Regions where two or three Districts are combined, an election will be held during the normal election process in the year preceding the end of the District Director's term in that Region which ends earliest. Whether a District Director in the Region runs and wins, runs and loses or chooses not to run, he will be entitled to an additional three-year term in a non-representative office or capacity. During this additional three-year term, the Board members will have full voting and other privileges held by other Board members.

New District Directors with terms that begin 1/1/2020 will be entitled to complete the term which they have been elected to serve.

If a District Director resigns or is unable to complete his term(s) for any reason, the District President in the District in which he resides will appoint a replacement for the remainder of the calendar year until a special election is held for the position of Regional Director for the following year. The details of the special election will be established by the Director of Elections so that a new Regional Director can be seated for the beginning of the next calendar year.

If a board member is unable to attend a meeting, no substitutes or proxies will be permitted.

The position of First Alternate and Second Alternate District Director will not exist after 1/1/20.

*Our bylaws currently state that "no decrease in the number of Districts shall shorten the term of an incumbent Director."
